

The *DBL Fatten Your Sheep System

GhR 2vs2 CQB, RvS AS CTE, BF1942, BF1942 Demo and CoD LADDERS:

The Fatten Your Sheep System is a ranking system that considers skill and risk willingness. You are ranked by your Sheep Fatvalue, or in other words, by the absolute skills of your clan. The Fatvalue is calculated by your and your opponents sheep bet and the sheep class difference.

When you look at a FyS ladder: you see the Rank(previous rank), Clan, Fatvalue, Sheep, and then the sheep class in form of sheep head icons. These sheep head icons give you a good indication how much sheep you should bet in a cb. Of course you are free to bet from 1 sheep to the maximum sheep limit:

Ladders	Sheep Bet Limits	
GhR 2vs2 CQB	First 8cbs: 20; then up to 50;	Last week of main season: 20;
GhR Team, BF1942, BF1942 Demo, CoD	# of players ^ 8; e.g.: 3vs3 = 3 ^ 8 = 24;	
RvS Team, RvS AS CTE	# of players ^ 10; e.g. 3vs3 = 3 ^ 10 = 30;	

Here is a helpful table of suggested sheep bets in relation to the sheep class. When you follow this table closely your sheep will become fat and your ranking will go up, but as said this should just help you betting the right amount. In general if you beat equal ranked clans you get a fair share of additional fatpoints. If you win against a clan ranked much lower than you are your fatvalue won't change much, if you beat a top clan on the other hand you can win a lot fatpoints. The lower your opponent is ranked the more sheep you have to risk to get the same amount of fatpoints, as you would do a normal sheep bet against an equal ranked clan.

Season Time	Description	Class Diff.	Suggested Sheep Bets
Start of the season	At the start of the season every clan has the same sheep class(2), so be careful with your sheep bets, because you may can't differ between extreme skilled clans and starters.	(0)	Starters: between 1 - 5 sheep per cb for the first clanbattles to get a feeling for the *DBL; Experienced: 5 - 10 sheep per cb;

Season Time	Description	Class Diff.	Suggested Sheep Bets
During the season	During the season your sheep class will probably change a few times. The class and further the class differences give you a good overview how many sheep you should bet and second how likely is it that you beat your opponent. The higher the difference is the more likely is it that you gonna win – the less points you can win at all. To compensate this lure other clans with higher sheep offer!		
	You are more or less equal clans.	(0)	Bet from 5 – 20 sheep
	1 class difference is not that dramatic. Both sides have good chances.	(1)	Bet from 5 – 15 sheep. Opponent: 5 – 15
	Your opponent has clearly more experience and superiour tactics. Be careful and may take an additional look at his win rate.	(2)	Bet 1 – 8sheep. Your opponent should offer at least 15 sheep.
	The chance is still very low for you to win. Still don't do any big sheep bets.	(3)	Bet 1 – 5 sheep. Opponent should lure you with at least 20 sheep.
	Your sheep class is 4 classes below your opponent, this means that you will very likely lose this cb. Be very careful with your sheep bet, but of course try it. In the case you gonna win you would get a great amount of Fatpoints added.	(4)	Only bet 1 – 5 sheep. Your opponent should offer you at least 25 sheep.
End of the season	At the last week of the main season you can't bet more than 20sheep. We advise you to select opponents in your class, because don't forget you not only win fatpoints, your opponent also loses them. So this makes it extra valuable and you can close ranking gaps faster.		

Additional tips:

- .) If your B players also want to cb, allow it just let them bet only a small sheep amount. You lose less in the worst case, but gain important experience.
- .) If you want to play a kind of test cb, to learn the system etc... just bet 1 sheep.
- .) If you have already won a few sheep you can of course risk more, because the sheep amount doesn't help you in the end.
- .) Be careful if you have lost all your sheep you are out of the ladder.
